TIMOTHY STIER NAMED OTS CHIEF ACCOUNTANT

WASHINGTON, D.C., Aug. 16, 1996 -- Timothy J. Stier has been named chief accountant at the Office of Thrift Supervision (OTS). He formerly was assistant chief accountant.
