### **OTS Releases April Enforcement Statistics**

WASHINGTON, D.C., May 19, 1998 -- The Office of Thrift Supervision (OTS) reported today that it completed three enforcement actions in April 1998.

This brings to 27 the number of enforcement actions by OTS since Jan. 1, 1998.

For the month of April 1998 there were:

- 1 cease and desist orders.
- 1 civil money penalty order.
- 1 removal and/or prohibition orders.
- 0 supervisory agreements.
- 0 prompt corrective action directive.
