



## Ben Rudolph Acting Senior Deputy Comptroller for Regional and Midsize Financial Institutions

Ben Rudolph is the Acting Senior Deputy Comptroller for Regional and Midsize Financial Institutions for the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency (OCC).

In this role, Mr. Rudolph oversees the supervision of national banks and federal savings associations between \$30 billion and \$500 billion in assets. He also serves as a member of the agency's Executive Committee. Mr. Rudolph assumed these duties in December 2025.

Prior to this role, Mr. Rudolph served as the Examiner-in-Charge of BMO Bank in the Large and Global Financial Institutions portfolio. Previously, he served as the Associate Deputy Comptroller for Risk, Resources and Examiner Development (RRED) where he served as an expert advisor to the Deputy Comptroller for RRED and provided expert direction for Midsize and Community Bank risk assessment efforts as well as supervision support through resource management and financial analysis.



Mr. Rudolph graduated from the University of St. Thomas in St. Paul, Minn., with a bachelor's degree in economics and a minor in computer science.
