**TERMINATION OF THE
AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN
CALIFORNIA INTERNATIONAL BANK, A NATIONAL BANKING ASSOCIATION
AND THE COMPTROLLER OF THE CURRENCY**

WHEREAS, to assure the safety and soundness of California International Bank, A National Banking Association (“Bank”)¹ and its compliance with laws and regulations, the Bank, by and through its duly elected and acting Board of Directors, and the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency (“OCC”), through the duly authorized representative of the Comptroller of the Currency (“Comptroller”), entered into an Agreement, dated May 13, 2010, AA-WE-2010-121 (“Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the OCC has entered into a new formal agreement with the Bank dated February 23, 2021, which replaces the Agreement; accordingly, the continued existence of the Agreement is no longer required.

NOW, THEREFORE, the OCC, through the duly authorized representative of the Comptroller, directs that the Agreement between the Bank and the OCC be, and it hereby is, TERMINATED.
