**ORDER TERMINATING THE
CONSENT ORDER**

WHEREAS, to assure the safety and soundness of JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A., Columbus, Ohio (“Bank”) and its compliance with laws and regulations, and after obtaining the Bank’s consent through its duly elected and acting Board of Directors, the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency (“OCC”) issued, through the duly authorized representative of the Comptroller of the Currency (“Comptroller”) a Consent Order against the Bank dated March 14, 2024, AA-EC-2023-50 (“Order”); and

WHEREAS, the OCC believes that the safety and soundness of the Bank and its compliance with laws and regulations does not require the continued existence of the Order.

NOW, THEREFORE, the OCC, through the duly authorized representative of the Comptroller, directs that the Order be, and it hereby is, TERMINATED.
