Interest Rate Risk: Interest Rate Risk Statistics Report

Summary

The Office of the Comptroller of the Currency (OCC) today published the spring 2021 edition of the semiannual *Interest Rate Risk Statistics Report*. The report presents interest rate risk data gathered during examinations of OCC-supervised midsize and community banks and federal savings associations (collectively, banks). The statistics are for informational purposes only and do not represent OCC-suggested limits or exposures.

Rescission

This bulletin rescinds OCC Bulletin 2020-91, "Interest Rate Risk: Interest Rate Risk Statistics Report," which transmitted the fall 2020 report.

The publication contains information collected from banks supervised by the OCC's Midsize and Community Bank Supervision department. The report is for informational purposes only.
